DUFFERIN-PEEL CATHOLIC DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARD (DPCDSB)

- Results for the DPCDSB indicate high performance in elementary reading and writing, but a decline in math.
- Elementary reading results of students who met or exceeded the provincial standard:
 - 79 per cent of Grade 3 students (80 per cent met the standard in 2018-2019)
 - 87 per cent of Grade 6 students (84 per cent met the standard in 2018-2019)

Elementary writing results of students who met or exceeded the provincial standard:

- 72 per cent of Grade 3 students (76 per cent met the standard in 2018-2019)
- 87 per cent of Grade 6 students (86 per cent met the standard in 2018-2019)

Elementary math results of students who met or exceeded the provincial standard:

- 59 per cent of Grade 3 students (60 per cent met the standard in 2018-2019)
- 44 per cent of Grade 6 students (47 per cent met the standard in 2018-2019)
