The owner is John Silvester, a former Phys Ed Department Head. The weblink is: http://www.creativesafetygames.com/ The cost depends on how much or little is asked for, in terms of the design and placement of the markings. Included in the cost, the company also trains up to 30 student leaders on effective ways to play the games and use the markings. This enables them to teach it to their class and/or their peers. I am told that all work is done in one day and paint dries 10 minutes after application. Hope this is helpful!
