Further to communications on the issue of candidates campaigning on school property, we continue to be advised of candidates being invited to school events, open houses, etc., handing out campaign materials and actively campaigning. This is contrary to DPCDSB Policy 1.20 Advertising.

Principals, staff and/or Catholic School Councils or Council members should NOT be inviting candidates for any office, including mayor, councilor, trustee, etc. to school events during the election period.

As indicated previously, current sitting trustees have the right, and are expected, to attend such events in alignment with their duties and responsibilities as elected trustees.
